SETTING THE STAGE

The late architectural historian Spiro Kostof once said, "Architecture is a social act and the material theater of human activity." Well, there seems to be no room that sets a better stage for human drama than a kitchen, whose function is clear but whose architectural value is all too often overlooked.
