



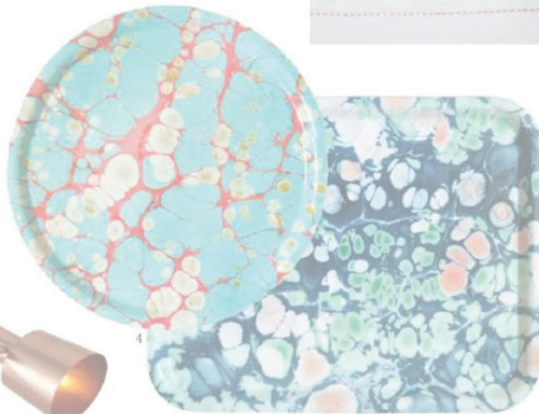

1 Foremost stage designer and king of illusion Oliver Messel (1904-1978) turned his hand to interiors as well, including his eponymous suite of rooms at the Dorchester. Besides making a chandelier from paper and fuse wire, his trademarks included a particular shade of green similar to that used on one of three versions of
