

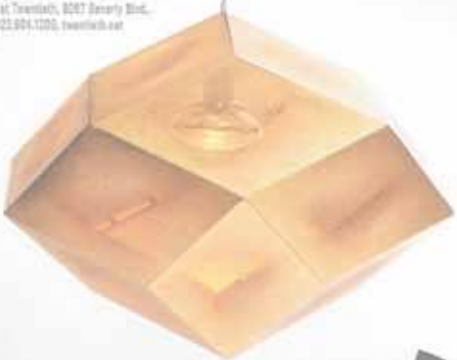

## Glow Moments

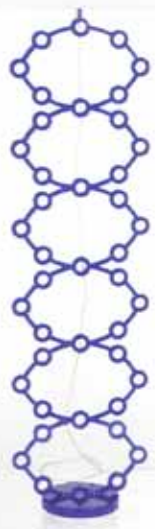
