These tactile squares—available in smooth, suede, faux croc, and more—are surprisingly versatile. The rich, buttery one-eighth-inch-thick sealed cowhide tiles we mounted in this master bedroom could also cover a tray, a desktop, or (now we're talking) a walk-in closet's floor. Apply them to a substrate (like plywood) first, then to the surface you want to cover.

We adhered these tiles to a four-by-eight-foot birch plywood sheet using contact cement (try [Wilsonart H2O contact adhesive](#); \$56, [cabinetmaker warehouse.com](#)), then hung the plywood with two French cleat brackets (Ook 200-pound French cleats, \$19 each, [homedepot.com](#)). Line it up 18 inches from the floor or with the bottom of your mattress, then frame it with whitewashed quarter-round molding.
